

Do you have a diagnosed health condition, injury or disability that is preventing you from working to your full potential?

MADEC can help!

MADEC may work with you one on one:

- to obtain work or study in your chosen industry
- to provide support if you are nervous about returning to the workforce
- if you are a volunteer participant
- if you are worried about loss of your job due to an acquired injury/health condition
- if you are between 14 and aged pension qualifying age you may access our Disability Employment Services
- with access to interpreter services if required

You may be eligible for MADEC Disability Employment Services if you:

- are on a Disability Support Pension (DSP) OR have a diagnosed health condition, injury or disability
- are able to work eight hours or more per week
- can work in open employment
- live in a local area where MADEC has a site that delivers DES
- * You must meet other eligibility criteria set by Disability Employment Services

We may need to refer you to Centrelink to determine your eligibility for our DES program, however we will support you with this process In conjunction with your career, advocate or family.
