

A person (or their employer) whose Employment is at risk because of their injury, disability or health condition can seek assistance via the DES 'Work Assist Program'. MADEC can help!

MADEC will provide:

- advice and assistance to Work Assist participants and employers to identify barriers and implement solutions that will maintain their employment
- assistance and information to Employers and staff to support the Work Assist participant in the workplace
- interventions such as physiotherapy, occupational therapy, pain management or psychological counselling
- access to services, workplace assessments and modifications available through Job Access and the Employee Assistance Fund

To be eligible for Work Assist:

- employee is having difficulties fulfilling the essential requirements of their employment due to injury, disability or health condition
- be currently employed and have been working in that job for a minimum of eight hours per week on average over a consecutive 13 week period or there is an expectation that the employment will last for at least 13 weeks for a minimum of eight hours per week on average
- be assessed by the DES provider as eligible to register for DES to maintain their employment

Participants must meet registration eligibility requirements .
