

Vaccinations Requirements for Aged Care Facilities Important Information

Influenza Vaccinations

As per South Australian Government Guidelines it is compulsory for all visitors entering an Aged Care facility to have received the annual influenza (flu) vaccine.

As a student undertaking practical work placement in an Aged Care facility you will need to provide evidence of your vaccination to MADEC and your potential host employer.

Evidence of immunisation status may include:

- Letter/record from health practitioner
- Immunisation history available from Medicare online

COVID-19 Vaccinations

Effective 8th September 2021 it is now mandatory for all workers in an Aged Care facilities to receive the COVID-19 vaccination.

This includes any students or volunteers undertaking practical work placement and they must supply evidence of their COVID-19 vaccination status to MADEC and your host employer.

Declaration

I understand that as part of my enrolment with MADEC work placement is required in an organisation where vaccinations are mandatory.

Failure to provide evidence of vaccination will mean placement cannot be completed and therefore my qualification cannot be issued.
